# **Problem Passages in Pauline Epistles — Galatians 3**

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## **THE PROBLEM**

The crux of the issue is connecting Gal 3:16 with Gal 3:29,

16 Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "And to your Seed," who is Christ.

29 And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

The thought that many people have is that this verse indicates that anyone who is "in Christ," is now party to the Abrahamic Covenant. In other words, all believers (who are those 'in Chirst'), whether Jew or Gentile, slave or free, male or female, are given all the promises of the Abraham Covenant through their union with Christ, who is the seed.
