B. He Is A Self-Condemning Hypocrite. 1c

1. By Judging He Is Acknowledging That the Activity Is Wrong.

2. By Practicing the Same Thing He Is Condemning Himself and Showing That He Is a Hypocrite.

3. He Is a False Judge.

C. There Is A True Judge. 2

1. This True Judgment Is Common Knowledge — “We Know.”

2. God’s Judgment Is According to Truth.

3. God’s Judgment Is Against all Those Who Sin.
