- TP3 is recognized as an usurper.
- A Weakened Assyria.
- In the OT, TP3 is known as "Pul".
- 3 major goals for his reign:
- Restoring Order in Babylonia.
- Defending the northern border from Urartu.
- Regaining control of Syria

- In 734 TP3 would launch a series of campaigns into the west that would last between 2 and 3 years.
- By the time these campaigns ended in 732, Damascus (Rezin) was forced to surrender.
- The end of TP3's reign and on into the future.
- The results of Israel defeat at the hands of the Assyrian would have profound and longlasting effects.
